

# Lake Arrowhead Auxiliary Meeting Wednesday, March 27, 2002

Co-President Loretta Nauta called the meeting to order at 8:17 PM.

**Secretary's Report:** Secretary Elizabeth Baresh e-mailed the January 22, 2002 meeting minutes and asked for corrections. One correction was noted and then the minutes were approved by a motion made by Ellen Scardena, second by Lyn Rand. Minutes accepted.

**Treasurer's Report:** Ellen Scardena reported that we have a total treasury of \$460.43 as of 3/27/02. Ellen recommended that we liquidate the jukebox account and put it into our checking account. Mary Ellen Stanton made a motion to close the jukebox account and put the money into checking, second by Sylvia Lacey. Motion passed. Ellen will move the money out April 1st. A motion was made by Mary Ellen Stanton, second by Bruce Simpson to accept the Treasurer's Report. Motion passed. Elizabeth Baresh will follow up with Rehana Flessner regarding the profit from Movie Night. The next family night is a pot luck and there is a small possibility for making money at the event.

## **Old Business:**

- **Plant Sale:** Because of the drought, it was decided to forego the plant sale this year. Lyn Rand suggested we sell hanging baskets instead, but the group decided we don't make enough money on the baskets.
- **Jukebox:** Elizabeth Baresh contacted Bob Petrin regarding selling back the jukebox, but he wants rock bottom prices. Jersey Works in Boonton might be interested. Lyn Rand suggested an ad in the Neighborhood Newspaper or the Daily Record, but since money is an issue, we decided not to pursue that at this time. Joan Lisi said she would approach Denville Billiards and see if they know of anyone who would be interested. We did get one offer from a renter to trade the jukebox for a player piano.

## **New Business:**

- **Fundraisers:**

  - **Car Wash:** The idea of a waterless car wash came up. The 'car wash' would entail vacuuming the inside, wiping down the console and washing the windows with Windex. Lyn Rand said her

church made a lot of money doing this event. We thought doing it during the Memorial Day garage sale would be great, but nobody could organize the event.

- Omelet Brunch: Bruce Simpson and Sylvia Lacey will organize an Omelet Brunch on Sunday, May 5<sup>th</sup> from 10:30 to 12.
- Pampered Chef Mystery Hostess night: the fundraiser on May 16<sup>th</sup> will be done as a Mystery Hostess party.
- Christmas Around the World: Janice Blinder talked about doing a Christmas around the World fundraiser in October. She will follow up with her friend. Tentative date as: Friday, Oct. 18<sup>th</sup>.
  
- Clubhouse Vacuum: Mary Ellen Stanton asked Lisa Spiess if we could purchase a new vacuum with the rental money.
  
- 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary: The Sunday of the 4<sup>th</sup> of July weekend, there will be a brunch and a boat regatta. It was thought that perhaps the brunch could make some money for the Auxiliary. Also Lisa requested help in designing an invite to go out to our alumni informing them of the upcoming events. If you know of any alumni's whereabouts, please contact Lisa Spiess. Mary Ellen Stanton said that AC Moore has note card paper and she went to Broadway printing who put it on paper for relatively little money.
