

**Lake Arrowhead Auxiliary Meeting**  
**Wednesday, April 18, 2001**

**Old Business:**

- **End of Summer Bash:** Will be held on June 16<sup>th</sup>. This event's main focus is on families, whereas the Beach Barbeque is for adults only. We are thinking of having lobster for the adults and hamburgers/hot dogs for the kids. Loretta Nauta was at the Picatinny Arsenal kick off day and there was a great DJ there. She called him and he was \$500 for 5 hours. He loves to do family parties. Loretta thinks he would be excellent. She has a contract and wondered if anyone wanted to discuss it. Janice Blinder questioned the price of the DJ. We want to keep the price really low, which will be a challenge since we are thinking of serving lobster and then hiring a DJ. Some discussion ensued as to how to handle the menu since this is an afternoon event.

  - Bruce Simpson made a motion to spend \$500 for the DJ for entertainment for the summer beach bash. Robin Bachman seconded it. Motion passed.
- **Easter Egg Hunt:** The event was a huge success. Very well organized. 45 children were involved which meant 450 eggs were done. Alex Todd did a wonderful job coordinating it. Mary Ellen Stanton will send her a thank you note for her excellent work.

- **Decorating class:** Elizabeth Baresh gave Loretta Nauta the contact name for potential decorating seminars. Janice Blinder mentioned she was interested in a Feng Shi seminar and agreed to investigate

it further. It was decided to bench this topic until the fall.

- Survivor Party: Nobody was interested.
- Garage Sale: Mary Ellen Stanton will send out a mailer to see if anyone is interesting in participating on Saturday, May 26<sup>th</sup>.
