

Lake Arrowhead Auxiliary Meeting

Wednesday, May 22, 2002

Officers Present: L. Nauta, B. Simpson, M. Stanton and E. Baresh

Co-President Loretta Nauta called the meeting to order at 8:47 PM.

Secretary's Report: Secretary Elizabeth Baresh e-mailed the March 27, 2002 meeting minutes and asked for corrections. The minutes were approved by a motion made by Sylvia Lacey. Minutes accepted.

Treasurer's Report: In Ellen's absence, no official report was provided, however some of the recent fundraisers did make money. The Pool Tournament made \$188, the Pampered Chef fundraiser made \$263 and the Omelet Brunch made \$7.85.

Old Business:

- **Pool Tournament:** Peter Rand coordinated a pool tournament, charging \$10 a head. The teams were made up of 2 people, one of which had to be a member. The event made \$188, which included a 50/50 and a \$10 donation from Darryl Walsh. Peter mentioned he would like to do it again and suggested possibly a ping-pong or checkers tournament this summer! Peter also talked to Billiard Towne about a cover for the pool table. They had a scratched and dented cover that they sold to us at a deep discount. Peter took advantage of the offer and purchased the cover as a donation to the clubhouse.
- **Pampered Chef:** The Mystery Hostess event was well attended and made \$263. This included the product fundraiser and the kitchen show fundraiser, in which after taxes and expenses, Elizabeth Baresh donated back her commission to the Auxiliary. Elizabeth might consider doing a Longaberger Mystery Hostess party next!
- **Memorial Day:** 20 families have signed up so far. We spend roughly \$71 in advertising. Also talked about the Memorial Day events: the baseball game at Butterfly Field, Wheels On Parade, the Cookout, Garage sale and bake sale. Mary Ellen stated we need volunteers to man the bake sale. She said that she listed the jukebox in the ads.
- **Jukebox:** Bob Petrin offered us \$300 for the jukebox, but we decided that was way too low!
- **Omelet Brunch:** 47 adults and 8 children attended the event. We made a \$7.85 profit.

New Business:

- **Beach Bash:** Peter Rand did some research and felt that the event was designed to break even on the food, while the Auxiliary would need to fund the DJ. He looked for an efficient menu that met our budgetary needs. The menu is as follows: lobsters, baked spuds, house salad, roll, and desserts. Drinks: ice tea, lemonade, beer and wine. Kids: ham, hot dogs, ice pops, munchies. The event starts at 3PM and the DJ will play for 4 hours, so he should go from 3:30 to 7:30PM. Peter said the lobsters are slated to cook from 5 to 6. \$9 per lobster on a wholesale price. Therefore we are charging \$18 per adult for lobster and \$15 for chicken. Peter broken down a list of jobs as follows: setup supervisor, drink person, lobster assistant, potato pusher, salad person (Linda Hackman), desserts/coffee person (Bruce Simpson possibly), clean up supervisor (Lisa Spiess).
- **Psychic Reading:** It was suggested we have a psychic come in and do readings as a fundraiser.
- **PartyLite:** Elizabeth Baresh booked a Party Lite fundraiser for November 4th.
- **Portraits:** We talked about doing the picture fundraiser again and who we would go with if we decided to do it.
- **Ice Cream Social:** will not be held this year since we have so many activities going on.
- **4th of July Cookout:** Mary Ellen Stanton will coordinate. Will double check with Lisa Spiess.

- Labor Day Cookout and Pot Luck: Loretta Nauta will coordinate.
- Oktoberfest: is now the 75th Anniversary dinner, but the date stays the same.
- Next meeting: will be held Wednesday, September 4th. Elizabeth Baresh will distribute flyers to announce the meeting.
