

# Lake Arrowhead Auxiliary Meeting

## Wednesday, October 16, 2002

### **Old Business:**

- **Logo Wear Sale:** Still taking orders. The "75<sup>th</sup>" logo is available till the end of the year.

### **New Business:**

- **Children's Holiday Party:** will be chaired by Karen Scornavacca and Jennifer Williams.
- **Adult Holiday Party:** Holiday party on the 15<sup>th</sup> of December: Robin Bachman will head it up. She needs a committee ~ Ellen, Loretta, Mary Ellen and Laurie volunteered. Make sure there is a 50/50. Would love to see us do Toys for Tots or something like that for the party. We could decorate the tree with ornaments and buy the ornaments & donate the money. Peggy Lefsky has helped in the past in conjunction with Coldwell Banker. Ellen will talk to Peggy to see if we could do something with the holiday party.
- **PartyLite Fundraiser:** Elizabeth Baresh is hosting a Partylite fundraiser at the clubhouse on Tuesday, November 5<sup>th</sup>.
- **Tastefully Simple Fundraiser:** Spoke to Karen Burns, the consultant, about doing a fundraiser on the 8<sup>th</sup> or 16<sup>th</sup> of November. The 15<sup>th</sup> might work for the party so we penciled it in.

- Movie Night: Picked 2 dates: November 23<sup>rd</sup> and January 4<sup>th</sup>. Elizabeth Baresh offered to spear head the events.
- Pooh In December: Monique Holenko mentioned she will be organizing a trip to the Pax Amicus Castle Theatre in Budd Lake to see "Winnie the Pooh" for the children. More details will follow.
- New Year's Eve: Talked of going to Casa Bella for dinner but that won't work since we can only go there from 5 to 7PM and that is too early in the evening. Lyn Rand was volunteered to talk to Manny, the owner, to see if something else could be arranged. She will report back to Loretta. Also discussed going to the Heritage Grill. Everyone thought it would be cheaper to cater it in house, but that is A LOT of work and nobody is up to the challenge.
- Next Meeting: Another meeting is set for January 15<sup>th</sup> at 7:30PM. We'll talk about psychic reading, beading party, game night, pasta night and skiing in winter.
